Summer Camp Packing List

- Foot locker (recommended) or large suitcase. Put your name on the outside.
- Combination (recommended) or keyed lock for above. Please place a copy of the combination or an extra key into a sealed envelope with your name on it in case the original is lost or forgotten. Give the envelope to the Scoutmaster.
- Clothing, packed in Ziploc-style bags. Shorts, T-Shirt, underwear, and clean socks for each day.
- Class A uniform (on a hanger), troop neckerchief, and woggle (slide)
- Light jacket or fleece pullover
- Rain coat or poncho
- Sturdy shoes for walking. "Crocs" or flip-flops may only be used in the evenings at our campsite. You will need sturdy shoes and socks the rest of the day. Lots of walking!
- Swim trunks - pack on top of your foot locker
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Twin-sized sheet for mattress
- Two towels, one washcloth
- Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant (put in a gallon Ziploc)
- Shower shoes
- Two flashlights, with extra batteries
- Boy Scout handbook
- Spiral notebook and pens
- Pocket knife (folding) – need to have Totin' Chip to use a knife
- One pair of long pants/jeans and a long-sleeved shirt if taking Swimming MB.
- Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, insect repellent
- Prescription medication – must be in original bottle and enclosed in a Ziploc bag with your name on it. Put instructions in the bag and give to the Scoutmaster
- Small music player with earphones for use at night.
- Water bottle
- Small amount of hard candy, granola bars, etc. Don't bring things that will melt. Put snacks into a Ziploc bag with your name on it. Must be placed in trailer at night.
- Camera (optional; disposable recommended)
- Small backpack (school book bag is good) or fanny pack
- Wristwatch
- Spending money for the Trading Post. \$25-40 recommended, plus an additional \$10 for group photo if desired. Photo money will be collected before we leave for camp.
- Camp chair with your name on it

Not Allowed:

- Cell phones, video games, video players or other electronic gadgets
- Sheath knives or any other weapons
- Fireworks
- Coolers, drinks, food, etc.
